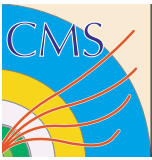


Technicalities of our TDR

- In some chapters there are boxes around the figures.
 - Did people change the template? How have the boxes been made?
 - Please remove them and stick to the template
- Please generate the Glossary Markers according to the instructions on the WWW
 - Otherwise we will not be able to generate a complete Glossary
 - My suggestion: try to reduce the number of abbreviations you are using to a minimum. The TDR is already now hard enough to read.
- Cross References : two possibilities
 - Easy for the writer: put “###” in front of every cross reference which goes outside of your chapter
 - Easy for the TDR editor: Everybody keeps a copy of the whole TDR and creates real cross references. (This is my preference: it only costs some MB of disc space. No further disadvantage.) Technical advantage of this method: You can guarantee that in the end all references are right: Framemaker allows to search the whole book for unresolved references.



- Question to Paris:
 - How have the parts been implemented?
 - Are the formats in all framemaker files the same?
- Solutions to Frans technical questions:
 - The date-variable can be updated easily for the whole book: The variable is changed in one file (for example FrontMatters.fm) and then the variables of this chapter are imported by the whole book.
 - How to use the compare facility of Framemaker ?
How to generate books / chapters with change-bars?

There is a problem in the current template which does not allow to compare the textflow of two TDR files. I assume it is a template bug or a framemaker bug (may be introduced with the new version of FM6)
